In our endeavours to promote undergraduate research, we have launched an initiative, the URNCST Journal Research Methods Primer, which has been specifically designed to provide undergraduate researchers with the opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of a commonly used scientific research method of their choosing. This provides students interested in advancing their career in research with the opportunity to experience peer-review and publication.
